DÉMODÉS

Technical rider

- Nomber of artists: 3 (Leandre Ribera, Enric Casso, Jordi Magdaleno)

- Duration: approximately 40 minutes. Fixed show

- Ideal space: square or street or intersection is not central, a little off, so that the public is expressly move to see the show.

- Stage size: Round, 12m in diameter. Flat ground preferably without platform. Audience seated in half circle.

- Lighting: White light in the event that the show takes place at night. (4000W minimum).

- Set-up: approximately 3 hours. A set-up area with vehicle (van) access, as close to the dressings rooms as possible.

- Parking for the van.

- The presence of a person belonging to the organization from the beginning of set- up to 1 hour after the end of the show

- Dressing rooms: As close as possible to the performance space, with mirrors, WC, chairs and bottled mineral water.

- In order to program two performances in one day, they must be in the same space and have a 3-hour break between the end of the first show and the start of the second.

Note: At one point in the performance we use fire (paraffin).

Totally controlled.
